## Who is "FRC"?

Faith Recovery Center is a Social Service Agency offering transitional housing, emergency shelter, and permanent supportive housing for homeless and chronically homeless individuals. FRC caters to serving individuals in recovery from substance abuse and/or mental health diagnosis.



## What We Do:

FRC goes to great length in taking individuals from the street and helping, teaching, equipping and supporting them while they arrest their disease and heal from the pain of living on the street. Our residents make changes and become productive members of society. FRC engages clients through case management, group therapy, twelve step meetings, didactics and the guidelines of the program that teach recovery, responsibility, structure, and accountability.

FRC- Case management consists of referrals for individual and group therapies, transportation, goal setting, employment and training, client assistance to help with basic needs such as, identification, medication, and personal items. We make referrals to Community Mental Health to address mental health issues. Our case managers are on site and deliver a spectrum of different supports and services.

Our goal at FRC is to help this population gain self esteem, life and daily living skills, independence, recovery and recovery support, and housing through a mixture of resources. Though the program is voluntary, it is our hope that each person stays long enough for the miracle of change to happen.

When a person is ready to leave the FRC program they have practiced a new way to live and applied certain principles in their lives to become productive members of society.

### Our Values:

Through discipline, encouragement, and person centered planning we strive to help individuals learn essential life skills and develop the confidence to face future challenges.

## How do I become a resident at "FRC"?

1. A person must first be homeless with verification of homelessness from agency or third party
2. Be chemically dependent to either alcohol or drugs and/or have a severe and persistent mental health diagnosis, such as but not limited to; Schizophrenia, Bipolar, Manic, Severe or Major Depression, Anxiety, PTSD, ect...
3. Pass a urine drug screen and breathalyzer
4. Not be on any synthetic drugs such as methadone, suboxone, subutex, or any designer drugs
5. Cigarette smoking is allowed in designated areas only
6. Individuals must be willing to be a part of a very structured program of recovery

The first step for the potential client will Contact us at (313) 383-9042 to complete an assessment and to see if the individual meets criteria for one of the programs at FRC. To meet criteria the individual must be homeless, in recovery from drugs and/or alcohol, have no sex crimes or violent crimes, and be willing to work hard and change their life.

The client must call themselves. Family and friends cannot complete assessment for the homeless individual.
